1. Welcome Hazel welcomed all to the review and gave a short presentation on her role and the Executive with particular emphasis on the upcoming vacancy for a Treasurer.
2. Presentations A short presentation by the leaders and sections was given to the parents to give a taster of life and activities in scouting. This was a great success.
3. Treasurer Report £21k this financial year which covers rents and insurance and this is obtained from subs and gift aid. Outgoings –capitation and hall hire/storage of equipment. Sea scouts have a grant for £2k to buy a dinghy and for training courses. There will be a profit of around £5k and it was proposed that the subs remain the same for the next financial year –(propose Rebecca Miles, Secunder Cathy Kistruck). The role of the Treasurer is a 3 year role, the first is working alongside the outgoing Treasurer to allow a hand over period, then one year on own with the third year as a hand over to the new Treasurer. Volunteers have been sought for the vacant position.
4. Executive Vacancies Andrew McLellan will be the new Monday Cubs rep (proposed by Gordon Smith, seconded by Andrew Lersley). Friday Beavers rep Elaine Beeley (proposed by Cathy Kistruck, seconded by Jo McCann).
5. Hazel closed the review and thanked the Executive and leaders for their work. Time will be given after the review for further discussions about the vacancies for interested parties. (Lisa Rolland is taking on the Treasurer role with Stuart McAdam taking on the subs role).
